

How to make your own Dreamcatcher!



Supplies:

1. small paper plate – provided by the library
2. yarn – provided by the library
3. paint or markers
4. beads – provided by the library
5. feathers – provided by the library
6. hole puncher

Steps:

1. Cut out the inside of your plate leaving an inch or so from the edge.
2. Using your markers or paint, decorate the plate.
3. Once it's dry, punch 10 holes along the inside of the plate. Punch 3 holes along the bottom edge, and 2 holes at the top.
4. Using the yarn, tie a knot at the first hole then weave it through the inside holes running the yarn across, then across and so on until you have yarn going in and out of each hole. Tie a knot at the last hole.
5. put a small piece of yarn through one hole on the top, tie a knot. Then add 2 beads or your choice, and tie the other end to the other hole, creating a little hanger on the top of your dreamcatcher,
6. Add 3 small pieces of yarn (about 4 inches) to all 3 holes on the bottom of the dreamcatcher. Add a bead to each piece of string, then tie a knot leaving a little bit of string at the end.
7. Tie 1 feather to the end of each string.

Once completed, you can hang your dreamcatcher above your bed in your room!
