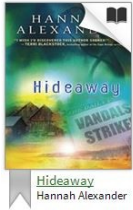


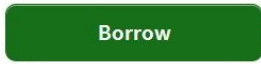
# How to Check Your Book Out

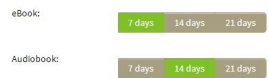
A new screen will pop up. You will see the following links:



Select to borrow the book.

You choose whether you want 7, 14 or 21 day loan period.

Click save.

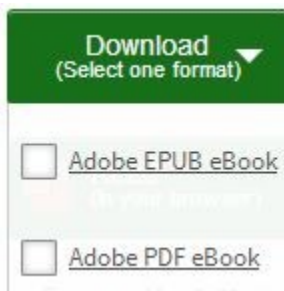


Or you may want to read this book but not at this time, you can add this book to your

Once you have clicked borrow, you have a couple of more options.

You can download the book and then you can choose which option to download it. We recommend EPUB.



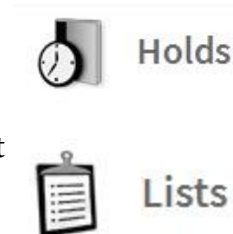
Or you can read the book straight from the browser.



If you check the book out or download it you will be asked if you want to renew it. This is available only if another reader has not put a hold on a book.

To place a hold on a book, simply click on a book that is checked out and it will ask if you would like to place a hold. It will ask for your email address and will notify you when the book is available. To view your holds simply click the holds icon.

# How Do I Access eBooks and/or AudioBooks?


Call or go to your local library and ask for a user name and password.

Once you have your access codes go online and go to either [www.allardlibrary.com](http://www.allardlibrary.com)'s home page and click the eLibraries icon at the bottom of the page or go to [www.elm.lib.overdrive.com](http://www.elm.lib.overdrive.com).

In the top right corner of the web page you will see an link that says Sign In.



A new screen will appear asking you to pick your library. Type in Allard and click on the Bibliothèque Allard Regional Library link. Click it once more on the link.

If you have already set up your eReader, computer or digital device on your computer you will be able to start selecting books right away.

If you have not set up your device please read your manual on how to do

this as it is essential to be able to access your book selection.



To download ebooks click the help button.

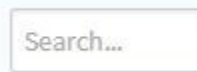
To download audio books click on the

## How Do I Find the Book That I Want?

There are a variety of ways to search for your book.



1. On the home page there is a search button

where you can search specifically for a title or author or go more general and pick a category.
