NEW RADON DETECTOR LOAN PROGRAM

Radon is a naturally occurring gas that can become a health risk if it accumulates in our homes. According to the program in late March, Manitoba Lung Association, it is the second leading cause of lung cancer and it can lead to many other lung issues.

Once we launch the you will be able to borrow a device for three weeks. If the average level of radon you see is above a certain number.
