KANOPY Launching Nov 1st



Starting November 1, explore the world of cinema with a new service called Kanopy! Kanopy is an on-demand streaming video platform for libraries that offers over 30,000 documentaries, classics, international films (including French cinema) and learning videos from hundreds of producers. A separate Kanopy Kids area features movies and TV shows for children.

To stream Kanopy films to your computer, phone or tablet you'll need:

- A valid Bibliothèque Allard Regional Library membership number.
- An account at Kanopy, which you'll set up the first time you log in.

• A computer with an internet connection OR the Kanopy app for iOS or Android (for watching movies on your phone or tablet). Kanopy will also work on your TV with certain devices.

Our Kanopy subscription gives every library member 10 tickets per month starting in November. When you're logged in, you'll see how many tickets are required to watch each film next to the play button. Some films require one ticket, some several tickets. Kanopy Kids is unlimited and tickets aren't required – you can stream as much as you like.

RADON DETECTORS AVAILABLE



November is Radon Action Month! Radon is a soil gas that can be found in

elevated levels in certain homes. Radon is the second-leading cause of lung cancer, surpassed only by smoking. It's important that everyone test their homes for radon, and take action to reduce their radon level if required.

Our library has five radon kits that members can borrow – three kits are at Allard and two are at Victoria Beach. Each kit comes with a digital radon detector and a booklet about radon. The detectors are easy to set up, so don't hesitate to borrow one – you can keep it for three weeks.

WINTER PORCH POT WORKSHOP



Back by popular demand, Lisa will be here Thursday, Nov 30th for a Christmas themed event... Winter Porch Pot

Workshop! The event starts at 6:30pm.

Cost is \$55 per person and

includes all the fresh greens, ribbon and basic embellishments.

Participants need to bring an outdoor planter like an urn or some other weather resistant container. 12 to 14 inches across and at least that deep to provide some weight. Participants can use a newly prepared container with fresh soil / sand or reuse a finished planter from last season. (that cannot be frozen on day of workshop) To prepare a used pot

simply cut off the fall plants and leave the roots intact which provides stability to hold the stems in place!

There is a minimum requirement of 8 people and maximum 12 for the event to take place.

GRANTS

As we wrap up 2023, we have so much to be thankful for and lots to look forward to! Our three partner municipalities (the RM of Alexander, the RM of Victoria Beach and the Town of Powerview-Pine Falls) and the Manitoba government provide annual funding for our two branches to operate – we couldn't do it without them. In addition, we received funding from the following organizations for special projects this year:

The Thomas Sill Foundation provided funds to refresh some furniture at our Allard branch, including new magazine shelving, shelving to display new books, a desk

and a couple of bookcases for our children's area.

We celebrated our 40th anniversary with support from the Manitoba government's Arts, Culture and Sport in Community "Community Celebrations" program.

We hired three summer students in 2023 with funding from the Manitoba Metis Federation and the Manitoba government's Urban/Hometown Green Team program.

We received funding through the Manitoba government's Heritage

grant program to digitize community newspapers – we're hoping to make this collection publicly available before the end of 2023.

We received funding from the federal Community Services Recovery Fund to add videoconferencing technology to our multipurpose room – this project is ongoing.

We received funding from the Manitoba government's Arts, Culture and Sport in Community Fund (small capital stream) to modernize our children's and youth area — this project is also ongoing and you'll see some exciting changes in 2024.

MAGAZINE SPONSORSHIP

At the beginning of each year, we launch our magazine campaign.
