FAQs ABOUT THE 2024 Read2Win Challenge

Who can participate in the challenge and prize draw?

The challenge is for anyone interested in reading. To be eligible for the prize draw, you must have a Bibliothèque Allard Regional Library membership. To get a membership, visit one of our branches or sign up online at <u>allardlibrary.com/explore/library-membership-form/</u>

Do I have to read books from the library?

You can buy, borrow from friends, borrow from the library or select a book from your personal collection... any source of books is suitable for the challenge.

Do I have to read books in English or French?

You can read books in any language.

Can I read an e-book?

Yes. The eLibraries Manitoba collection available with the Libby app is a great source of e-books.

I prefer audiobooks. Do those count?

Absolutely. The eLibraries Manitoba collection available with the Libby app is a great source of audio books.

I read a book that can fit into two of the categories on the challenge. Can I use it for both?

Each book can only be used for a single challenge category.

Can I read more than one book in each category?

You can receive one draw entry per category, for a maximum of 12 entries.

I read a book last year that fits into one of the categories. Can I use it?

Books should be read in 2024.

My child is interested in the challenge. Can they participate?

The challenge is generally aimed at adults, but children and teens are welcome to participate.

Do I have to read books from the categories in order?

You can complete the monthly challenges in any order.

How should I track the books I'm reading?

- keep track on the Read2Win form (available in print at either branch or on our website)
- track your reading on Goodreads
- any other way that works for you

Where can I find recommendations for books to read?
