The course offers basic first aid and caregiving skills for youth 11-15 years old. Participants learn how to provide care to children in a variety of age groups, and how to prevent and respond to emergen-

cies. The course also offers youth the skills to promote themselves as babysitters to prospective families.

The course will teach:

- How to be responsible and demonstrate leadership
- How to make good decisions and manage difficult behaviors.
- Information on children's developmental stages, and specific strategies for each stage

- How to feed, diaper, dress, and play with children and babies
- How to recognize and prevent unsafe situations, make safe choices and promote safe behaviors.
- First aid skills
- The business of babysitting.

There will be something for everyone so please stop by and as always, thank you for the ongoing support!






BOOK DISPLAYS AT THE LIBRARY
